Reducing Inbox Clutter: Clean Out

The dreaded email Inbox! I hear so many people sighing in frustration when even thinking about dealing with their personal and work email. I myself have spent several years fighting that battle as well. Here are a few tried-and-true tips for cutting the clutter so you can focus on what's really important in your inbox each day.

Fix Up Your Spam Solution:

Have all spam messages shunted to a separate folder for daily quick visual scan and deletion. **Unsubscribe, Unsubscribe, Unsubscribe:** You get lot of legitimate "commercial" email, you should consider whether you gain value from those messages. The truth is can find all of those information via a search or a quick visit of the company website in question.

Reroute Remaining Subscriptions: For any subscriptions that have survived your unsubscribe chopping block, consider how you can shift this less important mail out of your primary inbox.

The main benefit of reducing your inbox load is that it allows you to focus on the most important emails, responding faster. The other less tangible benefit is the reduction of "inbox avoidance" – when you don't even want to look for fear of having to slog through so much stuff.



Bring Your Own Device to Work—BYOD.

The latest IT Dilemma we all have to deal with every day ...

Today mobile devices are ubiquitous. Cell phones, smart phones and tablets are everywhere. Sony recently introduced a watch that connects to your cell phone so you can check incoming emails and texts without taking your phone from your pocket, purse or backpack. At the beginning of 2012 there were over 330 million wireless connection subscribers in the US. We used 2.3 trillion minutes of talk time in 2011 and sent an average of over 190 billion text messages a month. 31% percent of US homes are now exclusively cellular. I can remember when it was not uncommon to carry two cell phones. One was your work phone and the other was a personal phone. This was mostly driven by the high cost associated with the phones and the fact that companies paid for business phones and were billed directly by the carriers for the usage. Today, the lines between our personal lives and our work lives have blurred to the point that it is relatively difficult to tell where one begins and other ends.

So, here we are in 2012 with hundreds of million devices and wireless connections. Most of the devices are being used for both personal and business use. One company with 15,000 employees recently discovered that over 45,000 devices were connected to its network. That's a lot of "bring you own device" connections.

It's getting pretty complicated pretty quickly for businesses to deal with.

Consider the recent study from Lookout, a company that specializes in helping people find lost phones. Lookout believes that 30 billion dollars' worth of phones are lost annually and there is a good likelihood that we will all lose more than one in our lifetime.

When a single device goes missing, personal information, personal emails, business emails and all those addresses will be there for the taking. I always implore small- and medium-sized businesses that "it's time for a BYOD plan". Every IT admin should be thinking about whether they can remotely wipe employee devices and whether their company data is secure.

Do all of your phones have password protection activated?

Can the phones be locked remotely or can the data be removed if it comes up missing?

If so, do you have a communication plan in place to make sure you can wipe information in a timely manner? It has not taken us long to go from the closely managed mobility days to the BYOD days and it is unlikely we will be able to turn back the clock at this point. Having a solid plan as an IT Admin will set you up for success in protecting what's most important.



Why Data is Safer in the Cloud for Many SMB's

I hear it all the time. "I would never put my critical data in the cloud". Or, "Oh. _news headline here_ That's why I'll never move to the cloud". It's a prevailing point of view. The idea being that putting your personal data, documents, music, or compute on a computer other than your own means that you are somehow more vulnerable to privacy invasions, hacking, and other problems. There can be no argument that you are taking a risk by trusting someone else with your data.

However, I think it's worth pausing for a moment and asking yourself a question that fewever think about: Is your data really safer if you manage it yourself? Here are a few things you may want to consider. 1) You probably don't have a good, always-current backup of your data. 2) Your most sensitive personal information is probably already in the cloud. 3) Your computer is probably full of spyware, viruses, and other forms of malware.

4) Your laptop is at risk of being lost or stolen. Conclusion The cloud isn't perfect, but it provides an opportunity for the average SMB employee to step up their game in terms of providing better security, backups, and overall protection in what is otherwise a very dangerous technical landscape.
